Rules: IJF with the usual exemptions of no chokes for ages 12 and under and no arm locks for Jr. divisions (16 yrs and under) and Sr. Novice divisions. Match times 3 min. for juniors and 4 min. for seniors and masters. New 2013 rule changes will be in effect.

Eligibility: Current USA, USJF, USJA and ATJA

Awards: Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.



Procedure: Double Elimination. Where possible, Senior divisions will conform to IJF wt. standards. Senior divisions will also be separated into advanced (sankyu and above) and novice (yonkyu and below) categories whenever possible. The tournament directors reserve the right to alter pool make up to achieve the fairest

competitive situation. Junior divisions will be constructed based in age, weight and experience to achieve the fairest possible pool make up. For players wishing to "play up" see note on entry form.

Gi Participation Requirements

Blue Gi: Judoka with a blue gis must

also bring a white gi.

<u>Gi Belts</u>: Each participant must bring

their own blue <u>and</u> white belt

as sash markers.

A Note on Venue Requirements

- Dressing room facilities are quite limited. When feasible, judoka should come already dressed in their gi pants.
- A commercial concession stand is located at the tournament site. Please do not bring outside food & drink into the venue as it compromises our rental agreement.

History of the North/South Tournament

The North/South Tournament was started over two decades ago largely at the behest of Sensei Henry Okamura. It was conceived as a friendly competition between Chicago area judoka and players from St. Louis and Southern Illinois. Over the years, the tournament has expanded to include competitors from all over the Midwest. Team competition is a tradition held over from the original N/S concept.


